2019-2020 Contracts/Agreements – Superintendent

1. Shari L. Fox, Ed.D. - Originally approved by the Board of Trustees on August 13, 2019. Contract increase to extend contract term through June 30, 2023. Increase not to exceed \$46,451 annually; funded by General Fund.
2. Soboba Casino Resort - Soboba Casino Resort will provide meeting space and food service in the Soboba Resort Banquet Room for the SJUSD Annual Welcome Back Breakfast on August 4, 2020. Cost not to exceed \$10,800; funded by General Fund.

1. Air-Ex Air Conditioning Inc. Estimated annual revenue of \$7,500.

Contract C1002398 increase is for additional delivery charges on the roofing materials for New Middle School #4. Increase not to exceed \$10,000; funded by General Fund, Capital Facilities Fund and Measure Y.
