**RESOLUTION NO. 20-21-16
HONORING DR. JUDY D. WHITE
ON HER RETIREMENT FROM RIVERSIDE COUNTY OFFICE OF EDUCATION AS
RIVERSIDE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of San Jacinto Unified School District honors Riverside County Superintendent of Schools Dr. Judy D. White on her retirement from Riverside County Office of Education and her 42 years in public education; and

WHEREAS, Superintendent White has led the Riverside County Office of Education as both Superintendent of Schools for preschool through 12th grade and Chief Executive Officer for the 4th largest county office of education in the state since being appointed in January 2017; and

WHEREAS, during Superintendent White's term the high school graduation rate rose to 90.1%, the highest rate among the largest counties in California and the highest rate in county history; increased the college-going rate, access to financial aid, reduced chronic absences and established a robust countywide visual and performing arts offering; and

WHEREAS, in 2018 Superintendent White was instrumental in bringing together the first Unity Conference where schools, businesses, places of worship, non-profits and government leaders came together; in 2019 she started the first Student Unity Conference bringing together hundreds of high school students to develop leadership skills and student voice to help shape their future; and
