BP 5112.5 (a)

Closed Campus

In order to keep students in a supervised, safe, and orderly environment, the Board of Trustees establishes a closed campus at all district schools, however seniors who meet eligibility requirements may use lunch passes to leave campus during the lunch hour. The Board views this program as a way to improve and reward student academic achievement and attendance. Eligibility requirements are based upon academic performance, behavior and attendance standards. The open campus privilege may be revoked for seniors who do not meet the eligibility standards.

Students shall not leave the school grounds at any time during the school day without express permission of school authorities. Students who leave school or who fail to return following lunch without authorization shall be considered to have an unexcused absence and subject to disciplinary action.
